The Government's \$112.7 million *Keeping Melbourne Moving* plan to ease congestion on arterial roads within 10 km of the CBD includes a range of initiatives to improve the flow of road-based public transport.

This will include \$37.8 million for targeted tram and bus priority programs and \$2.2 million for additional priority treatments on two key tram routes. The remaining initiatives under the plan, including the \$12.6 million investment to extend and standardise clearway times, will also improve the flow of trams and buses on key public transport routes.

This forum will include presentations and encourage discussion on:

- strategic direction of improving public transport under the *Keeping Melbourne Moving* Plan,
- a public transport operator's perspective on types of improvements which assist travel times,
- current standards and guidelines on treatments to improve public transport.
