Governance and Strategy Updates

Strategic Plan Launch

The Board received an update on the launch of AITPM's Strategic Plan. Feedback has been positive from members and stakeholders.

Rebrand

The Board received an update on the progress of the trading name change and rebrand. All is on track for launching at the AGM.

Code of Conduct Endorsed

Following a consultative review process and positive feedback from State Branches, the Board endorsed the AITPM Code of Ethics, Professional Standards and National Code of Conduct. This will be presented to members for approval at the 2025 AGM.

The Board approved updates to several key policies to reflect current legislative requirements and member engagement strategies:
