

AITPM Board Communique – March 2025

The AITPM Board met in Sydney on 13 March 2025 to discuss key priorities and make decisions to advance the organisation's goals. Below is a summary of the main items:

1. Strategic Plan Approval

The Board approved the consensus version of the Strategic Plan. A public-facing version will be developed for members and stakeholders.

2. 2025 National Transport Conference

Planning for the conference in Adelaide is progressing, with a new co-convenor appointed and a review of the conference strategy underway to improve broader industry involvement and local engagement.

3. Financial Position and FY26 Budget

The Board endorsed the financial report, noting that the CEO is forecasting a result that will exceed budgeted expectations. The FY26 budget was approved, emphasizing conservative financial outcomes, investment in growth and improved reporting practices.

4. Membership Satisfaction Survey

The Board endorsed a benchmarking survey by Ipsos to assess member satisfaction, with a contra deal negotiated for sponsorship recognition.

5. Governance Enhancements

A new Board Evaluation Framework was approved to strengthen governance practices. The board also endorsed updates to the Director Eligibility & Board Composition Policy.
