ABOUT THE 2022 ONLINE TECHNICAL CONFERENCE SERIES

The 2022 Online Technical Conference Series will be held over a period of three weeks during November 2022.

The format will involve recorded video presentations for pre-viewing, followed by a series of Live Q&A sessions with the presenters.

The Live Q&A sessions will each be an hour in length, with 1 session per day 4 days a week over the 3-week conference period.

The recorded video presentations will be available prior to the commencement of the live sessions and will be available to delegates as a library of technical content during and post-event.

The Conference will be delivered in three Streams:

- Plan
- Model
- Move

In both 2020 and 2021, the Online Conference Series events each attracted more than 400 delegates and generated a significant amount of online engagement amongst speakers and delegates, as well as with the industry at large.
