The establishment of the YPN in 2012 and continued support for learning and development of members represents a core action of the AITPM's Strategic Plan 2013-2017.

The Australian Institute of Traffic Planning and Management (AITPM) provides a central point of reference for practitioners in traffic and transport planning and management. Members of the Institute are linked primarily by a common vocational interest rather than by similar academic qualifications alone.

The YPN is targeted at professionals (up to 35 years of age) who are working, or interested in the industry. Since its inception, each AITPM State Branch has formed a YPN committee to help plan and run events, the key focus of the YPN.

The AITPM Young Professionals' Network (YPN) provides a platform for young professionals working or interested in transport, to network, learn and develop their skills alongside like minded individuals within the industry.



## Providing Tailored Local Events for Young Professionals

Each AITPM state branch hosts 3-4 events on an annual basis, tailored specifically to the needs and interests of young professionals.

These events range from career development sessions, with industry experts providing insight into their journeys within the field and offering salient advice, to technical forums on topical issues within the industry and tours of major transport projects being delivered in each state.

They provide attendees the opportunity to learn from industry experts, add to their professional development, keep informed of current trends and build their professional networks.
